

Water Smart Pipeline Program Ends, But Gardening Resources Abound

The Water Smart Pipeline, a horticultural helpline offered by The Garden has officially closed. The program was funded by the Stanley Smith Horticultural Trust, from March 2009-February 1, 2011.

For ongoing assistance with water-smart gardening, the Garden offers free "Ask the Horticulturist" tours monthly, and Garden docents lead free tours every weekend, 10:30am on Saturdays (year-round), and 1:30pm on Sundays (winter and fall only). In addition, a self-guided tour of The Water Conservation Garden's educational exhibits provides a wealth of information for the do-it-yourself gardener.
