ABOUT THE EXHIBIT

The Water Conservation Garden's mission supports sustainable landscape design and the use of low-water-use plants, with emphasis on plant specimens native to California or similar climates around the world. Creating landscapes that attract butterflies is critical to sustaining the local environment – particularly since many natural butterfly habitats have been lost to or altered by human activities – and encourages the use of low water-use plants to promote water conservation.



The Dorcas E. Utter Memorial Butterfly Pavilion provides a demonstration of how plants that attract butterflies can be used in residential landscapes and inspire environmentally responsible introduction, cultivation and distribution of plants with ornamental horticultural value. Opened in March 2014, the exhibit features an 18-ft. tall, 600-sq. ft. metal enclosure (called a "vivarium") with drought-tolerant plants, pathways, water features, interpretive labeling, and hundreds of butterflies representing species native or endemic to San Diego County. In addition, educational programs teach about butterflies and the types of plants that attract them.

The exhibit was made possible by a generous gift from the family of the late Dorcas Utter, one of The Garden's most beloved volunteers, who founded The Garden's docent program.
