They will assist with animal encounters and participate in educational garden events when needed including our Lil' Sprouts Preschool Storytime held once a month. (8:30-12:30pm Tuesday-Friday with select Saturdays).

# **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Learn tour curriculum and Garden exhibits information.
- Educate students about water conservation, plant adaptations and conservation relate material.
- Respobibsle for fieldtrip planting activity, recycling lesson, program setup, props and materials, and program breakdown
- Interact with students, teachers, and parents in a manner that is positive, upbeat, and friendly.
- Responsible for gathering survey information at the end of each program.
- Ensure program materials are stored in a safe and organized manner
- Replenish program materials: scavenger hunts, soil, gemstones and mulch weekly.
