Rules and Registration Info

All Photo Entries Must Be Taken At The Garden

- 1 The Water Conservation Garden Photography Contest, November 9, 2024 is open to open to amateur photographers only. **There are no entry fees.**
- 2 **Reservations are required.** Contact Sally Long at sallyscfs@gmail.com for a reservation by October 31, 2024. **Unregistered photos will NOT be accepted. Entry Submissions:** Photo Entries can be made at The Water Conservation Garden entrance or other arrangements made with Sally Long. Photos must be turned in by **Monday, November 4, 2022**. Photos will be judged on November 6. **No entries submitted the day of judging will be accepted. Remember: All photos must be taken at The Garden.**
- 4 Limit of **four (4) entries in total** with no more than **two (2) entries** per class. No duplicate photos are allowed. No photos that have won awards in other contests can be shown.
- 5 Any type of camera or smartphone can be used. The use of photo editing software other than cropping, rotation, dodging, burning, or minor clean-up will be penalized.
- 6 **MOUNT and MAT all photos. Mat size = 11x14" Photos 8x10" only.** Photos can be horizontal or vertical. **No glass frames.**
- 7 All entries should have the name and contact information on the back of the photo and an entry tag attached to the front left corner. Tags are available at The Water Conservation Garden when you turn in your photos.
- 8 **Question: When can Photos can be picked up? Typically we do this after the show or other arrangements made for pickup. It would be nice to show it for a longer period of time. We can even move the photos outside, I have protection for the prints so they won't be damaged.**
- 9 9. Any photos not picked up, become the property of The Water Conservation Garden and may be used for educational purposes. All rights to photos are retained by the photo owner. Exhibitor agrees to allow The Water Conservation Garden to display the photo at the show and publish it on their website or in printed materials.
- 10 **The Water Conservation Garden is not responsible for the exhibits in the event of damage or loss.**
